Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP
prior to departure from the foreign port or place and at least
24 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at K59B.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30
minutes. If your ETA deviates outside these parameters,
previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must
contact CBP to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the tarmac to begin the inspection.
- All crew and passengers will exit the aircraft and present their passports, visas, pilot's licenses, medical certificate, aircraft registration and user fee decal (if applicable).
- A CBP Officer will inspect the aircraft.
- Passengers and crew may depart only after the inspection is complete.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from the foreign airport and at least 24 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at K59B.
- You will be asked to call again one hour prior to arrival.
