Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP
prior to departure from the foreign port or place and at
least 4 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at
KGON.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30
minutes. If your ETA deviates outside these parameters,
previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must
contact CBP to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park on the ramp.
- The aircraft control tower can direct you in if needed.
- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin the inspection.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- Regulated waste/garbage will be collected by CBP from the aircraft crew.
- Passengers can depart directly from FIS at the conclusion of their inspection.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- The Port of New Haven provides inspection services to this airport. This airport does not have a CBP facility and officers travel one hour or more to provide service.
- Permission to land must be made within the Port's operational hours.
- The Port has limited staffing on the weekends and services are available on a case-by-case basis in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

- Advise CBP if transporting live animals, weapons, hunting trophies or commercial imports.
