Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP
directly one hour prior to "wheels up" from the foreign port
or place and obtain an arrival log number.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30
minutes. If your ETA deviates outside these parameters,
previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must
contact the CBP port to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- All internationally arriving aircraft must taxi directly to the CBP Federal Inspection Station (FIS) immediately upon arrival.
- The FIS is not attached to an Fixed Base Operator (FBO), and service from a FBO must be arranged prior to arrival.
- All passengers, crew and luggage must be presented inside the FIS for inspection.
- Upon completion of the CBP inspection process, aircraft will taxi to the servicing FBO.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- FBO services must be secured prior to arrival.
- The servicing FBO will meet the aircraft upon arrival at the FIS to assist with the CBP inspection process.
